Dear Ms. P.

At its hearing on June 11, 1986 the Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

- 1) That you obtained unauthorized assistance in the writing of four term tests in Mathematics 132Y held at Erindale College during the summer evening session of 1985, contrary to s.E.1(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.
- 2) That you were party to the offence of personating a member of the University, namely yourself, on four term tests in Mathematics 132Y held at Erindale College during the summer evening session of 1985, contrary to s.E.1(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

The Tribunal accepted your plea of guilty to these charges and imposed the following sanction: a suspension from the University of Toronto from the date of the hearing until the conclusion of the 1986/87 winter session.

In giving reasons for this sanction the jury stated that they had accepted the submissions of counsel for the University and for yourself. The jury felt that the facts that this was a first offence and that you had admitted guilt to the Tribunal were in your favour; however, they noted the gravity of the offence and its repeated nature, and that you had failed to admit the offence at the first opportunity and failed to identify the accomplice. The jury noted the inappropriateness of other available sanctions. They believed that this sanction would be a deterrent both to you and to others and would give you the opportunity for rehabilitation. The jury stated that they would encourage you to seek professional guidance from your college registrar or other academic advisor with respect to your future academic work.
