Dear Mr. V.

At its hearing on July 13th, 1987 the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That on or about April 13th, 1987 you were a party, under Section F 1(a)(iv) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour, to an offence whereby Mr. L. did personate you at an academic examination in the course APS 100S (S. 10 101) contrary to Section F 1(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour. You did abet, counsel, procure or conspire with Mr. L. with regard to Mr. L.'s personation of you at your final examination in the course APS 100S on April 13th, 1987.

The jury accepted your plea of guilty to the charge and made the following recommendation to the President of the University of Toronto:

That you be expelled from the University.

This sanction will be recorded permanently on your transcript.

The jury unanimously agreed with the University's Discipline Counsel "that the appropriate sanction be expulsion. We have reached this conclusion on the basis of the evidence presented."

Information concerning rights of appeal may be found in Section L of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The deadline for filing an appeal by you or by the University is August 7th, 1987.
